 All adults are invited to room 10 (Choir Room) for a discussion of mass incarceration and prison reform. Our facilitators will be Susan Clampet-Lundquist and John Pace. Susan is an associate professor of sociology at Saint Joseph's University. Her research focuses on urban neighborhoods, families, adolescent risk behavior, and social policy. *Coming of Age in the Other America*, her book written with Stefanie DeLuca and Kathryn Edin, examines urban inequality through the experiences of young adults in Baltimore. She has taught courses in the Inside-Out Prison Exchange Program since 2008 and is a member of the Inside-Out Think Tank at SCI-Graterford. John is an Inside-Out Prison Exchange Program Associate and JWOP Reentry Coordinator with Youth Sentencing & Reentry Project (YSRP), both based in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Recently released from prison after serving 31 years, John obtained his Associate's Degree and Bachelor's Degree from Villanova University. John is thrilled to be able to utilize his experience doing what he loves to do, helping to facilitate transformative educational experiences for people to learn across their differences, and working with returning juvenile lifers and youth.
